Message from Ms. Maddy:

The Family Survey Spring 2013 Results are in. 100% of the families surveyed felt that their child was well cared for and that their child was happy and enjoyed participating in our program. 64 % of the families were "Very Satisfied" and 36% were "Satisfied" with the overall quality of the program. According to the survey, the most popular reason why families chose our program was for the age-appropriate curriculum. Comments that the families wrote where, "Times available are good." "Great socialization skills and nutrition.", "Very caring teachers always available to communicate.", "My child has learned a lot in this preschool. We are able to integrate what he has learned in our interactions at home.", "Thank you for all you have done to make my daughters first school experience wonderful!", "We are happy that we found this program." The two most popular events that the families participated in last year were the Holiday Program in December and Regatta Race Event in February. 90% of the families, that turned in the survey, participated in Parent/Teacher Conferences. They found the conferences were informative and 90% of that group felt their child achieved his/her goals and was ready to move forward. The areas where families feel there can be improvement is in Parent Interactions, Parent Involvement and Cultural Activities. 90% of the families are aware that we are participating in the Self-Study for Accreditation through NAEYC (National Association for the Education of Young Children).

Our "Back to School Night and Ice Cream Social" will be **Thursday August 8, 7:00-8:00 PM**. The evening will start in Criswell Hall at 7:00 and end in the classrooms. Ice cream will be provided by the school and families are asked to bring a topping or item to share. To help with this event, please see the "Ice Cream Social Sign-Up" sheet at the Sign In/Out Table. At this event, classrooms will be open for you to learn what is happening and ask questions about what to expect in the coming year.
