# Message from Ms. Maddy:

The Family Survey Spring 2014 Results are in. 100% of the families surveyed felt that their child was well cared for and that their child was happy and enjoyed participating in our program. 83% of the families were "Very Satisfied". According to the survey, the most popular reason why families chose our program was for the age-appropriate curriculum. Comments the families wrote were: "Great program and we love the low ratio." "Very caring teachers, always available to communicate." "Ms. Kassie and Ms. Shirley were wonderful and observant teachers."

The most popular events that the families participated in last year were the Holiday Program in December, the Painting and Taco Party in January, the Regatta Race Event in February, and the Open House in April. 100% of the families, that turned in the survey, participated in Parent/Teacher Conferences. The families found that their child achieved his/her goals and was ready to move forward.

The areas where families feel there can be improvement is in "Parent Involvement" and better communicating how we share our Christian teaching with the children.

100% of the families who completed this survey were aware that we are participating in the Self-Study for Accreditation, through NAEYC (National Association for the Education of Young Children). However, only 60% understood how Accreditation affects the families and 40% would like to learn more about the process.
