Peace With Justice Offering NEXT WEEK—June 15

The 1980 General Conference created a church-wide Peace with Justice program assigned to the General Board of Church & Society. The 1988 General Conference established Peace with Justice Sunday as the first Sunday after Pentecost to give congregations a single, more convenient date for the offering and a name that clearly identifies the ministries it supports.

The annual conference keeps 50% of the receipts for Peace with Justice ministries within its boundaries. The remaining 50% is used for Peace with Justice ministries related to the General Board of Church & Society.
