Today different denominations celebrate One Great Hour of Sharing on various dates, but the cooperative spirit remains.

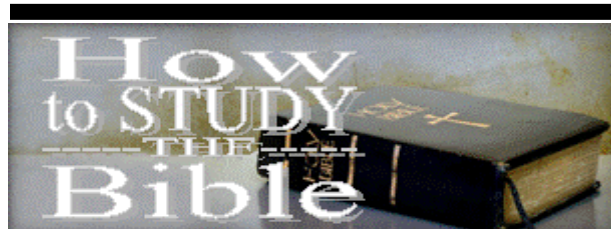

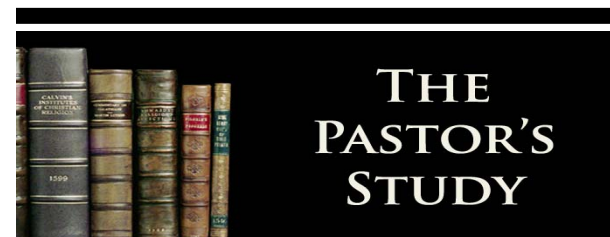
