## Message from Ms. Maddy:

The Spring Family Survey Results for 2022 are in. All the families who participated in the survey were either very satisfied (81.3%) or satisfied (18.8%). 100% of families felt the program promoted their child's learning and development and were happy with the care they received. Some comments: "Loving environment, my son is happy, close to work, and flexible." "Very happy with our experience at AGUMCC." "I'm grateful for the Bible Stories and teachings about God. It has sparked conversations at home with my child. Thank you."

The top reasons why families enrolled in our program are 1) Age-appropriate curriculum, 2) socialization, and 3) Low child-to-teacher ratios. 96%) participated in Parent/Teacher Conferences and found them informative since they learned how their child has grown and developed. 100% of the families surveyed attended Parent Teacher Conference. All of them found their child's conference informative. The majority (87.5%) of the families felt the staff communicated well. The two most preferred ways they liked to receive information were in person and through Childpilot. Ms. Andrea and I have really enjoyed our first weeks of TK having a great time learning about your children. We hope that they are enjoying their new class as the "Big Kids," as many of them

We look forward to getting to know each other more as the year continues.

In July, we spent time getting to know each other. Children explored and enjoyed the areas in the classroom, such as the manipulatives, blocks, library, science, math, and dramatic areas. We also introduced the class schedule in the front of the class in picture form, colored their puzzle piece for our "class family puzzle, decorated their birthday candles for our birthday board, and colored their helping hands, which they will use daily to identify their daily job.

We started with our summer theme, in which children decorated ice cream cones during table work time—Ms. Andrea modeled how to do a color-bynumber ice cream worksheet and practice tracing their names. In addition, in the second group, children showing them the ropes. They have all done very well danced and moved using their creative movements during music and movement.

In August, we will be introducing our ZooPhonics alphabets and numbers. On Tuesday and Wednesday, we will introduce our "Share" time. Children can bring items like pictures, drawings from the internet, or a magazine corresponding to the letter of the week. For example, A is for an apple, and bring a picture of an apple. We will laminate their paper and put them together in an ABC binder.
