
Message from Ms. Maddy

Welcome to AGUMCC's 18th year! We are so glad that you have chosen AGUMCC to provide your child with the best care and early childhood education. Currently, our program has 32 students. Word of mouth is our best advertisement. Thank you for telling others about us! We still have openings in our Preschool Class for children who can use the toilet successfully on their own and 3 years of age by September.

Share your summertime fun with us. Bring pictures or souvenirs to share from your family travels. Summer is a busy time for many families, as well as for the staff. Please let your child's teacher know if they will not be attending school due to vacation or illness. Teachers record absences related to illness on their classroom illness log.

We appreciate your support in helping to keep everyone healthy. A well-balanced diet, plenty of rest, and regular hand washing are KEY to happy and healthy children, families, and staff. At the beginning of each day, we ask that your child use hand sanitizer or wash his/her hands when entering the program. As we travel from place to place, we also bring germs with us, and we'd like to keep them from spreading as much as possible. Please have your child use sanitize or wash hand when he or she enters or leave the program. This will help prevent bringing in or taking germs to and from school.

What makes AGUMCC different from other childcare centers? We offer a low child-to-teacher ratio. In the toddler program, we maintain a 4:1 ratio. In our preschool and TK classes, it is 6:1. We pride ourselves on having a quality program that offers an Emergent Curriculum. Emergent means following the children's lead and introducing new and exciting activities to sustain the children's interests over time. This type of curriculum is socially and intellectually engaging and personally meaningful to the children.

As teachers, we are excited to welcome new friends to AGUMCC and welcome back our graduating Toddler Class. I have sent "home a welcome packet that tells you all about our preschool class. This packet includes helpful information regarding classroom expectartions, the classroom environment, and curriculum information. Please take time to read the packet and contact me with any questions you may have. We will talk more about our classroom on parent orientation night. We can also 💤 be reached on the Child Pilot app and will return messages as soon as possible. Please make "sure to send an extra change of clothes for your child to keep at school in case they are needed. For our nappers, please send a fitted *w*sheet, a small blanket, and a small stuffed animal or doll if needed.

This month, we will focus on the fun time in summer through story and sharing of experiences. For sensory, we have kinetic sand with beach toys. We will do summer and beach arts and crafts. We will ease the children slowly

into the routine. This month we will work on building relationships and knowing our new friends as they transition. We have sent home a poster board for you to do "A Family Board" project together. This board should include pictures of your child, their name, and pictures of their families. They can also include stickers, drawings, pictures of pets, and anything they feel is special to them. Once your "Family Board" finished please returned it to school. We will be laminated it and make it available for your child to have in the classroom.
