



FISCAL YEAR 2022/23

We ended the 2022/23 Fiscal year with a \$7K deficit. Not good, but we ended last year with a surplus, which we used to cover this year's deficit. Regular tithes and offerings were \$298K, which was \$22K below plan. Holiday and Loose Plate offerings were \$3K above plan. Expenses were approximately \$13K below plan.

STEWARDSHIP DRIVE

As of July 23, we received 73 Estimate of Giving cards totaling \$268,778. Some of the cards returned were to increase their previous pledges. Yay! This puts us at 78% of our goal of \$320,000, or about \$70K short. We have slightly over 100 regular givers, which indicates we have not yet heard from about a third of our regular givers. If you have not submitted an Estimate of Giving, please do it now so I can stop nagging, wrap up out Stewardship drive and prepare our 2023/24 budget. If you have submitted an Estimate of Giving, THANK YOU VERY MUCH. Since we appear to be falling short of what we need, please consider increasing you giving and submit a revised card.

We are in the process of moving our accounts from Mechanics Bank, to Interfaith Federal Credit Union. If you have any church checks drawn on Mechanics Bank, please cash it promptly as those accounts will be closed soon.




