





#### Isaiah 40:28-31

Have you not known? Have you not heard?
The LORD is the everlasting God,
the Creator of the ends of the earth.
He does not faint or grow weary;
his understanding is unsearchable.
He gives power to the faint,
and strengthens the powerless.
Even youths will faint and be weary,
and the young will fall exhausted;
but those who wait for the LORD shall renew
their strength,

they shall mount up with wings like eagles, they shall run and not be weary, they shall walk and not faint.

#### Mark 1:29-39

.As soon as they left the synagogue, they entered the house of Simon and Andrew, with James and John. Now Simon's mother-in-law was in bed with a fever, and they told him

about her at once. He came and took her by the hand and lifted her up. Then the fever left her, and she began to serve them.
