The choir occasionally sang impromptu, such as at a little church in Castle Combe (not pictured).





Wesley Chapel, London



The Chancel Choir rehearses every Wednesday evening in the sanctuary from 7:00pm to 8:30pm during the choir season which typically starts late August and ends with Music Sunday which is the first Sunday of June.

During the choir season, the choir sings at the 10:30am worship service on Sunday mornings. They gather at 9:45am for warmups and a little rehearsing.



The Chancel Choir will perform cantatas from time to time. Some of these have included: The Seven Last Words of Christ, Festival of Hymns, Tenebrae: A Service of Darkness, We Will Know Peace, Festival of Lessons and Carols, our 125th Anniversary Cantata, and the two pictured above.

The Chancel Choir will also occasionally attend choral workshops and performances as a group.
