Message from Ms. Maddy


Parent participation is key to the success of our school! This month we are having our third annual "Family and Friends Fun Day". This day will include a Trike-A-Thon, TRI TIP BBQ lunch, and old fashioned carnival games. Ask your child's teacher what activities their class is providing at the carnival and see how YOU can help. There are many ways you and your child can take part in this big event. You can sell BBQ tickets, get pledges for the Trike-A-Thon, buy game tickets for the carnival, and/or bring your child with his/her trike to ride at the Trike-A-Thon. If you collect \$25 in Trike-A-Thon pledges, you will get 10 free tickets toward the carnival games. If you collect \$100 in pledges you will get a "Carnival Wristband" and all the carnival games will be FREE. We need lots of volunteers to help with the class game booths. This is a chance to meet other families and to build a strong community of friendship within our program.

It is Parent/Teacher conference time. Conferences provide a great opportunity to build relationships between teachers and families. They also provide an opportunity to share information about the children and to set goals for them to work toward in the months ahead.
