





# The City of Arroyo Grande Centennial Celebration Parade

The following streets will be closed for the Centennial Parade from 4 PM to approximately 9 PM - TODAY (7/10).

- Beginning at E. Grand Ave. and Brisco Road and east to the corner of E. Branch and Mason Street; and Halcyon Road from El Camino Real to Dodson Way.
- Bennett St. from E. Grand Ave. to Cornwall Ave.
- Nevada Street from E, Branch St. to the Car Corral.
