

HAITI: SUPPORTING THE DEAF COMMUNITY

UMCOR is working with Mission Hearts to supply food for 400 people currently living in a camp for deaf people in Port-au-Prince. After last year's earthquake, many deaf people found themselves without a place to live or food to eat. They banded together and moved to a tent camp in the capital. Of the 400 deaf, hard-of-hearing, and hearing people at the camp, including 68 children, only 105 are employed. UMCOR is providing food assistance for the people in the community through partner Friends of Deaf Haiti, a group of deaf Haitians who live in the United States.
