HELP UMCOR HELP HAITI SUPPORTING DEAF COMMUNITY

UMCOR is working with *Mission Hearts* to supply food for 400 people currently living in a camp for the deaf in Port-au-Prince.

Of the 400 deaf, hard-of-hearing, and hearing people at the camp (including 68 children), only 105 are employed.

UMCOR is providing food assistance for the people in the area through partner *Friends of Deaf Haiti*, a group of deaf Haitians who live in the US.


