Parent participation is key to the success of our school! This month we are having our Fifth Annual "Family Fun Day". This day will include a Trike-A-Thon, TRI-TIP BBQ lunch, and carnival games. Ask your child's teacher what activity the class is providing at the carnival and see how <u>YOU can help</u>. There are many ways you and your child can take part in this big event. You can sell BBQ tickets, get pledges for the Trike-A-Thon, bring your child with his/her trike to ride at the Trike-A-Thon, and/or buy carnival game tickets at the event. If you collect \$25 in Trike-A-Thon pledges, you will get 10 free tickets toward the carnival games. If you collect \$100 in pledges you will get a "Carnival Wristband" and all the carnival games will be FREE. We need lots of volunteers to help with the many activities that are happening at this event. This is a chance to meet other families and to build a strong community of friendship within our program.
