

When you submit a prayer request, it is shared with a small group of church volunteers -- *real people like you and me*. This group (known a the Intercessory Prayer Group) will then, with thoughtful, heart-felt intent, embraces that prayer request and takes it before God the Father.

We invite you to take advantage of the <u>Praver Book</u> in the Narthex; your request will be lifted up during worship today. The Prayer Request Card in the pew in front of you if another tool. Simply fill it out completely and place it in the offering plate as it passes. Be sure to indicate if your request is to remain private. We will be praying for you!

"Don't worry about anything; instead, pray about everything. Tell God what you need, and thank him for all he has done. Then you will experience God's peace, which exceeds anything we can understand. His peace will guard your hearts and minds as you live in Christ Jesus." Philippians 4:6

The ACTS of Prayer

A simple acronym based on the <u>Lord's Prayer</u> to help us engage in prayer with the correct devotion and attitude: <u>ACTS</u>: <u>A</u>doration, <u>C</u>onfession, <u>T</u>hanksgiving, and <u>Supplication</u>.

- <u>Adoration</u>—"Our Father who art in Heaven, Hallowed be thy name." means to worship and acknowledge His majesty; speak to His greatness.
- <u>Confession</u>—"Forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors." Here we are to see our sins and agree with God about the things that we have done wrong. During prayer, they will come to our mind for us to seek forgiveness and deal with it to make a resolution where we can. Confess also means to be accountable to one another. We cannot grow closer to God with unconfessed sin.
- <u>Thanksgiving</u>—"For Thine is the Kingdom and the power and the glory forever." Our prayer life to be centered in gratitude for what he as done for us. Recall where God has been merciful in your life. Understand that he loves us more than we know or can fathom. Have the inward awareness that God has indeed been with you all through the day.
- <u>Supplication</u>—"Give us this day our daily bread...Lead us not into temptation but deliver us from evil." This is called petition; our most earnest and humble requests before God. It is seeking not only our needs, but the needs of others depending on Him for EVERY aspect of our lives.


