Message from Ms. Maddy:

The Family Survey Spring 2015 Results are in. 100% of families surveyed felt that their child was well cared for and that their child was happy and enjoyed participating in our program. 77% of families were "Very Satisfied" and 23% were "Satisfied". According to the survey, 96% of families chose our program for socialization, 92% chose us for the age-appropriate curriculum and 58% chose us because of work. A couple of the comments families wrote were: "Excellent program, very happy", "I feel my son is thriving in this program, I'm not survey, but imagine that the staff makes him feel loved and proud of himself"

The most popular events families participated in last year were the Family Fun Day in October, our Holiday Program in December, the Pizza and Boat Painting event in January, and the Taco Dinner and Regatta Race event in February. Family involvement is key to our program's success. The areas families noted there can be improvement were in the areas of "Parent Involvement" and "Better Communication". When asking families how they would like to be involved, 84% said they would participate in socials and fundraising events; 58% would help outside the classroom; and only 1% wanted to help inside the classroom.

88% of families, that turned in the survey, participated in Parent/Teacher Conferences. All of those families found their child's conference was informative. They also felt their child achieved his/her goals and was ready to move forward.

.65% of families, who completed this survey, were aware that we are participating in the Self-Study for Accreditation, through NAEYC (National Association for the Education of Young Children). However, only 60% understood how Accreditation affects families and 35% would like to learn more about the process.
