Mark your calendar: "Positive Discipline" is coming in March. This six week course is for parents and caregivers. It provides positive guidance techniques that include connection before correction with kindness and firmness. The classes will be held at AGUMCC. The class is also open to the community. This course will be offered Tuesday nights, March 1 through April 5, from 6:00 to 8:00 PM. The series will be led by Ms. Maddy, who is a Certified Positive Discipline Educator.
