The Summer Results for 2017 Family Survey are in. 100% of families surveyed felt that their child was well cared for and that their child was happy and enjoyed participating in our program. 75% of families were "Very Satisfied" and 25% were "Satisfied". According to the survey, the top reasons why families chose our program was for our "age-appropriate curriculum" and the "low child to teacher ratio". 90% also chose us for our location and hours of operation. A few comments provided by families included: "This is a very high quality program." "Love AGUMCC! A very dedicated staff. Positive energetic feeling throughout." "Cindy Bo is such a compassionate caregiver. I feel so comfortable with her caring for my child. She is amazing." "Very happy with communication and the positive nurturing environment. Happy with the level of structure." "Great Program."

The most popular events families participated in, this past year, were "Back to School Night" in August and the "Holiday Program" in December. Family involvement is key to our program's success. 50% of the families surveyed have helped with classroom activities such as making playdough, cooking, providing snack, or helping with laundry.

93% of the families, that turned in the survey, participated in Parent/Teacher Conferences. Of that group, 93% found the conferences to be informative and acknowledged that they learned more about their child's growth and development.
