If most of our friends are at church we’ve missed the boat, unless we just brought them with us. Connect the dots and build the church!

To succeed in this ministry we are in need of more help with the meals. There are funds available to reimburse the cost.





### GOD'S STEADFAST LOVE...IN ACTION

#### SEVEN YEARS OF UMCOR RESPONSE IN HAITI

Over the past seven years, the United Methodist Committee on Relief (UMCOR) received a total amount of \$46,357,729. Through your generous donations and support, UMCOR was able to respond to the needs in Haiti immediately following the earthquake, as well as to commit to long-term development plans. These long-term development plans were carried out by UMCOR, as well as through partnerships with other organizations. UMCOR was there not only to prioritize the health, education, and safety of Haitian residents, but was also there to support reconstruction of homes damaged after the earthquake. In 2016, Hurricane Matthew caused widespread damage in Haiti and, according to the Haitian government, killed more than 500 people. UMCOR responded through partnerships and provided emergency supplies to areas that were severely affected. Despite the major storm, Haitians remain resilient. Over the last seven years, UMCOR has had the privilege of working with the Haitian community to develop resilience after the January 12, 2010 earthquake.

to intergenerational education in low income communities providing special programming for children provided by young adults seeking ministry opportunities.
