Our Toddler Schedule

8:00 - 8:30 am Early Birds

For children who arrive before class begins. The group plays indoors and in the courtyard.

8:30 - 12:00 am Morning

Morning class offers group and individual experiences: free choice, art, sensory, snack, song, story and outside play. (End of Toddler's Partial Day Program)

12:00 - 12:30 pm Lunch

Children enrolled in the Full Day option will bring a healthy lunch to be enjoyed with the other Toddlers.

12:30 - 3:00 pm Nap / Rest Time Children bring their own bedding for nap and stay for the rest of the Full Day option.

2:30- 3:30 pm Outside Play 3:30-4:00 pm Snack and Pick Up Time

Children enjoy outside play or inside play, snack story time, art and free choice activities.

Our Preschool Schedule

8:00 - 8:30 am Early Birds

For children who arrive before class begins. The group plays indoors and in the courtyard.

8:30 -12:00 pm Preschool

Morning class offers group and individual experiences: stories, art, free choice activities, snack, music and outside play.

12:00 -12:30 pm Lunch

Parents bring a nutritious packed lunch for their child. Children eat with their teacher, followed by toileting, stories, and puzzles.

(End of the Partial Day Program)

1:00-3:00 pm Nap / Rest Time Children bring their own bedding. Rest is for 1 hr. Children that are awake can participate in an afternoon activity indoors.

3:00- 3:30 Outside Play

3:30-4:00pm Snack and Pick-Up Time

Children enjoy outside play or inside play, snack, story time, art and free choice activities.

Age Requirements:

Toddler Age: Children must be between 18 and 30 months of age by start date.

Preschool Age: Children who are 3 and 4 years old by start date and **potty trained** may attend until they begin kindergarten.
